



**GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA**

**Sub:** For existing Nursing Schools and Colleges, Starting of new courses and increase of seats - Relaxation of certain conditions imposed in Government Circular No.HFW 22 MPS 2005, dated 02.07.2007.

**PREAMBLE:**

In the Government Circular No.HFW 22 MPS 2005, dated 02.07.2007 certain conditions were imposed for establishment of new nursing schools and colleges, starting of new courses and increase in intake of seats in existing Nursing Institutions in the State shall have their own building and 100 to 150 bed strength hospitals within 05 years of their inception. The Government was also aware that certain school, colleges and institutions do not have their own building or hospitals to conduct courses. In the interest of students studying in the institutions, the Government has relaxed in imposed conditions and passed this order.

**GOVERNMENT ORDER NO.HFW 168 MPS 2014 (2), DATED 27.10.2014**

The conditions and regulations in para 3 (a) and 3 (d) (i) in the Government Circular No.HFW 22 MPS 2005, dated 02.07.2007 shall be amended as follows:-

**“For existing nursing Schools and Colleges, affiliation to start fresh course or increase intake of seats subject to conditions that the said Institutions must have their own building and own hospital within five years from the date of this order.”**

In continuation, the other conditions in circular No.:HFW 22 MPS.2005, dated 02.07.2007 and consequential orders issued in this regard shall continue to be in force.
